The LEC has done a great job putting together some great events, with new faces in leadership roles, and trained many new leaders through our Lodge Leadership Development in August.

This past year Aal-Pa-Tah has continued to support Tanah Keeta in many ways. At Spring Ordeal we completed a rather extensive list of service projects and did a great job of cleaning out many of the common areas around camp. The following weekend, APT was once again integral to the running of the 2nd Annual Gator Grind. At Summer Gathering, we did a fantastic job of getting TK ready for Summer camp, building tents.

For Fall Festival, we were dealt a serious curve ball when Hurricane Irma hit, and hit camp pretty hard. There were hundreds of trees down, many of which blocked access to the campsites and many of the roads throughout camp. We had over 150 brothers show up at camp to clear the debris. Teams were sent to all parts of camp and removed the fallen trees, cut and stack firewood, and remove all of the smaller debris. During the rescheduled Fall Festival, we successfully helped run the second annual Gator Grind and the inaugural Gator Trail Run. I could not have been more proud of the job that APT did to make sure that the event was a success. It is more than safe to say that APT saved the day! Not only did we manage to do our part for Gator Trail, but we also completed a rather extensive request list of about 30 items that needed to be addressed at camp. Crossing each one off of the list as the day went on and handing over a completed checklist to the Rangers was a true testament to the APT spirit of giving!

We also have several new and exciting accomplishments – life size chess, APT 237 75th Anniversary book and the *2018* Where to Go Camping Guide. Winter fellowship is slated to see the installation of the hammock stand and the knot tying wall – but delayed thanks to Irma.

OA Unit of Exellence

Since the Troop is the primary and most vital platform from which the Scouting Program is delivered, therefore it is only right that the OA supports the units of our council to the best of our ability. The OA Unit of Excellence Award is given to units that excel in incorporating the OA into their annual planning and participate in the lodge in elections, lodge events and meetings, & implement the OA Troop Representative program. The award is broken into five major parts:

- 1) Leadership: Implement the OA Representative program in your unit
- 2) Participation: At least 50% of unit OA members attend a Lodge event in addition to their Ordeal
- 3) Elections: Hold an Election and have 100% of elected candidates complete their Ordeal
- 4) Planning: Maintain an active planning process that prevents overlap between Lodge and unit events
- 5) Conversion: At least 30% of eligible Troop members seal their membership by converting to Brotherhood.

When I first met you at the S4 Conference at Sand Hill Scout Reservation, I was anxious to have the chance to meet you again in December- you did not disappoint!



that is pictured, you can help the Lodge donate to the James T. Sasser Campership fund to further support your fellow Scouts.


