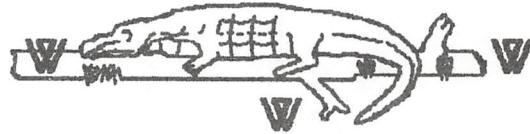

What You Need To Know About Fall Fellowship

2. The fee for the weekend will be only \$14.00 and this will include the weekend patch and all cost for weekend.

3. Registration begins at 7:00 P.M. on Friday and departure is 11:00 A.M. on Sunday.

Brotherhood Ceremony "Ten Months As Ordeal?"

 - c. Describe your specific plans for giving service in the lodge program .



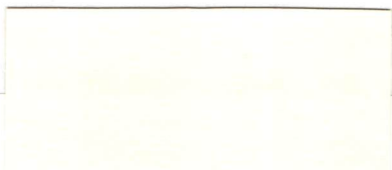
OBLIGATION
