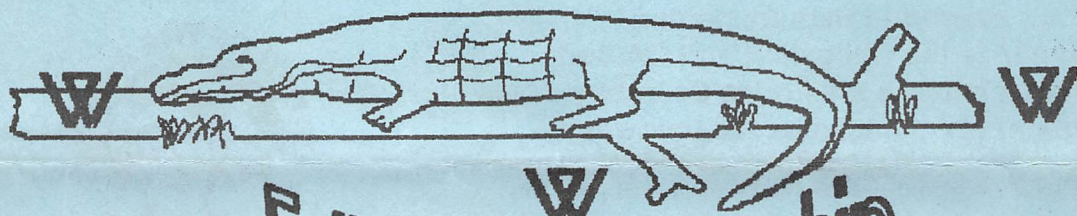

#### BROTHERHOOD— SATURDAY

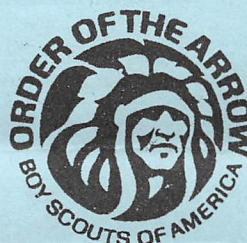
If you received your Ordeal at least 10 months ago then this weekend is the time to complete your induction by going through the Brotherhood Ceremony. Last year's Make-Up Ordeal eligible. There are no task but there are a few simple things to learn (see reverse). **There is an additional \$10.00 fee.**

#### THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

1. Registration begins at 7:30 p.m. Plan to stay until before 11:00 a.m. on Sunday.
2. Everyone who attends the OA weekend for any period of time must register. The only partial registration is for Saturday; the fee is 8.00 (one meal).
3. The gates will be locked at 12:00 p.m. You may not leave camp during the times listed above (see number #1) without permission from the Lodge/Staff Advisor or the Lodge Chief.
4. After 11:00 p.m. you must be quietly in your campsite or in the Dinning Hall.
5. Youth members (under 21) are expected to participate in the planned weekend activities.

**Brotherhood Requirements:**

1. Memorize the Obligation and OA Song.
2. Write a letter to the Lodge Secretary (Nick Eggen) which includes the following:
  - a. Explain what you think the Obligation means.
  - b. Describe how you have been fulfilling the Obligation in your troop or post and everyday life.
  - c. Describe your specific plans for giving service in the lodge program .
